

Sometimes I need to talk to people through video chatting.




I might video chat with my teachers and kids in my class.

I also might video chat with family that doesn't live in my house, or with some of my friends.






One thing that I should try to do when I am video chatting, is to look at the screen on the device so the other person can see my face


